National Institute of Development Administration Eligibility Criteria for Regular Applicants (Self-Financed) for Master of Public Administration (English Program) Major in Public Policy and Strategic Management Round 4/2026 for the Academic Year 2027

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Public Administration (English Program), Major in Public Policy and Strategic Management, for the Academic Year 2027.

1. Qualification of Applicants

1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or are studying in the last semester (and to graduate before the first term starts) in any field from universities or institutions accredited by the Higher Education Commission.

1.2 Applicants who graduated from abroad must provide a letter of accreditation for acquired degrees that is issued by the Higher Education Commission.

2. Application Forms

Applicants are required to apply and submit all supporting documents only via <https://admission.nida.ac.th>.

3. Application Procedure and Payment of Fees

Applicant must print an invoice from the system and pay the application fee of 200 THB via:

1. Bangkok Bank
2. Counter Service (at 7-Eleven stores)
3. Mobile/Internet banking

Remarks:

1. The application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
2. Applicants who fail to submit the required supporting documents shall be deemed ineligible under the admission announcement and shall not be listed as eligible candidates for the examination.

3. An application is considered complete only upon full submission of all required documents and payment of the application fee within the period specified by the Institute.

2) In case the applicant has already been accepted but the documents No. 4.9.1 - 4.9.3 are disqualified by the approval of the Bureau of Standards and Evaluation, the Higher Education Commission, Ministry of Education, student status will be automatically terminated, or subject to NIDA council's discretion.

4.10 English Proficiency

4.10.1 Applicants must submit a valid English test score: TOEFL 500, IELTS 5.5, NIDA TEAP 500, or an equivalent test recognized by a standard organization or the government of the applicant's country. The test results must have been obtained no more than 2 years (1 year for NIDA TEAP) prior to the submission date or before the first semester ends. (These scores apply only for admission; for enrolled students requesting an exemption from the basic English course, the required scores differ according to the program's exemption regulations); or

4.10.2 A Bachelor's or Master Degree certificate mentioned that the program is English-medium instruction and the graduation must not exceed 3 years with a minimum GPA of 2.75 for Bachelor's Degree and 3.25 for Master Degree by the time the applicants submit the results to the institute or before the first semester starts; or

4.10.3 Proof of the completion LC4001 and LC4002 (the courses conducted by institute) following the institute's criteria and must not exceed 2 years by the time the applicants submit the results to the institute or before the first semester starts; or

4.10.4 Proof of English proficiency by supplying evidence that applicants were born/or are citizens of a country where English is the primary language; or

4.10.5 Proof of being an active NIDA student status and having studied in any English program or international program.

Remarks: 1) Applicants might get the permission to not provide evidence of English Proficiency, depending on the consideration of the program committee and shall be approved by the Dean.

2) Evidence of English proficiency must be submitted after admission and student registration, and no later than the end of the first semester.

*NIDA reserves the right to verify the applicants' qualifications at any time. Applications who do not have the required qualifications will not be admitted to the program. No refunds will be issued. If an applicant has already been accepted but is subsequently determined to be disqualified, the student status shall be deemed null and void.

**NIDA reserves the right to cancel the enrollment of any programs which cannot meet the requirement regarding minimum number of student registration with no application fee refunds.

National Institute of Development Administration Eligibility Criteria for Partial Scholarship Applicants for Master of Public Administration (English Program) Major in Public Policy and Strategic Management Round 4/2026 for Academic Year 2027

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Public Administration (English Program), Major in Public Policy and Strategic Management, for the Academic Year 2027 in the category of Partial Scholarship (Type 2). Under Type 2 scholarship, the scholarship recipients shall be exempted from tuition fees only for the entire duration of the program (2 academic years) but remain responsible for all other fees.

1. Qualification of Applicants

1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or are studying in the last semester (and to graduate before the first term starts) in any field from universities or institutions accredited by the Higher Education Commission. **The minimum GPA of 2.75 (on a 4.00 GPA scale) is required.**

1.2 Applicants who graduated from abroad must provide a letter of accreditation for acquired degrees that is issued by the Higher Education Commission.

Remark: For scholarships, the Institute reserves the right to select recipients from the most qualified applicants based on faculty allocations. Scholarship type or non-award selection is at the committee's discretion. Criteria and conditions follow the Institute's official scholarship regulations (<https://edserv.nida.ac.th/scholarship/>). Selected applicants who are not eligible for a scholarship must pay regular tuition and fees.
